

Teton's Approach to Consent

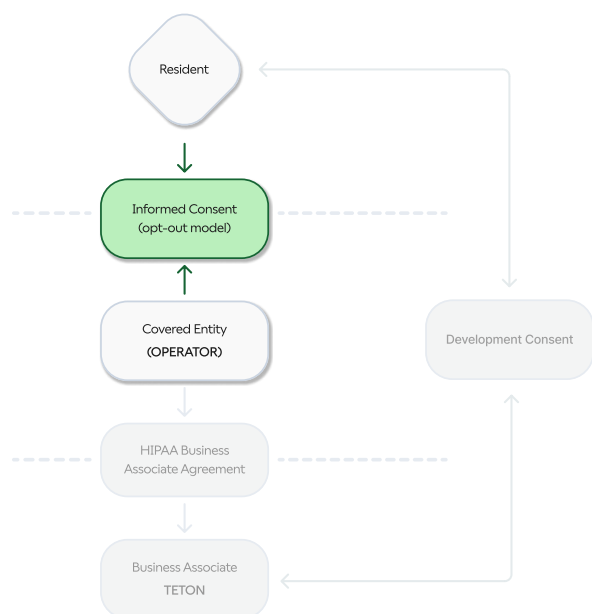
We built in privacy and dignity for residents from the start. It touches every aspect of our system, from how we process data locally, within the room, to how we show the activities in the room. This allows the system to be in operational use with informed consent.

Teton does not store any personally identifying information. Data is processed and de-personalized locally, with raw images deleted immediately after processing.

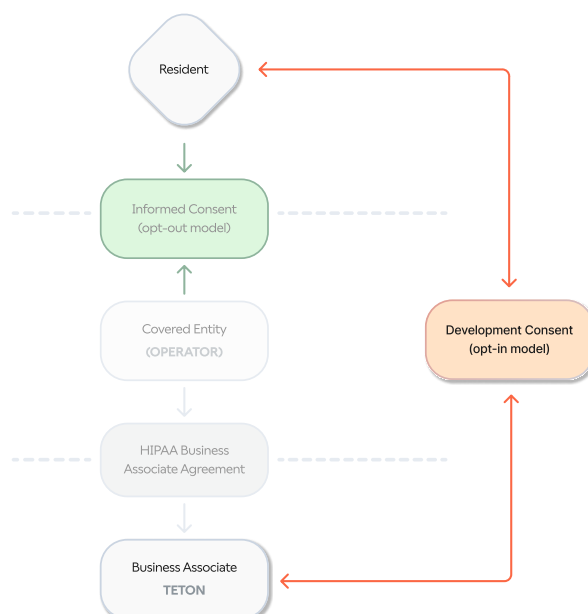
Best Practice to Acquire Consent:

Our clients have the most success using an opt-out, informed consent form between their organization and their residents. Information about the Teton solution is shared with each resident (and their authorized representative when needed) both via email and through an on-site Family Session offered by the Teton team. After the session, any residents who do not wish to utilize the system may provide a written opt-out intent.

Does Teton request any consent? Prior to going live, Teton will ask for consent from residents to help train our system. This is an optional consent, but we do look for 50% of your residents to provide it. This allows us to effectively troubleshoot any challenges and make the system as accurate as possible for you.
